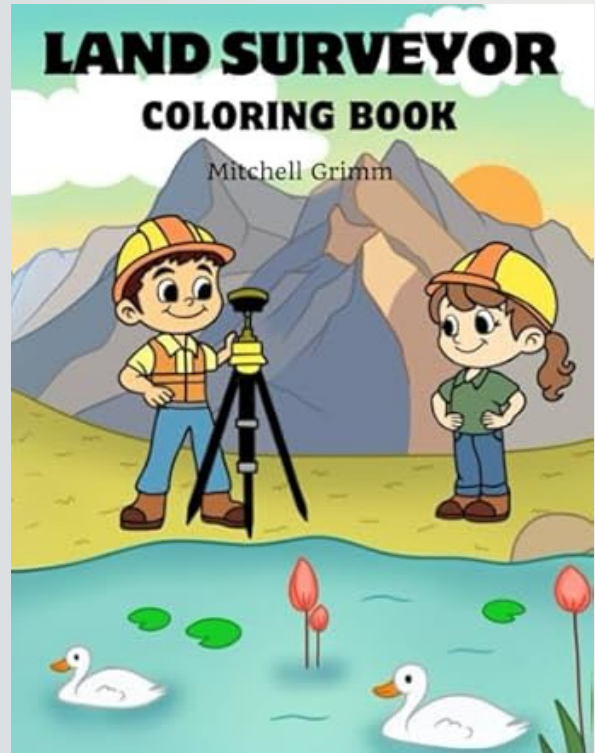
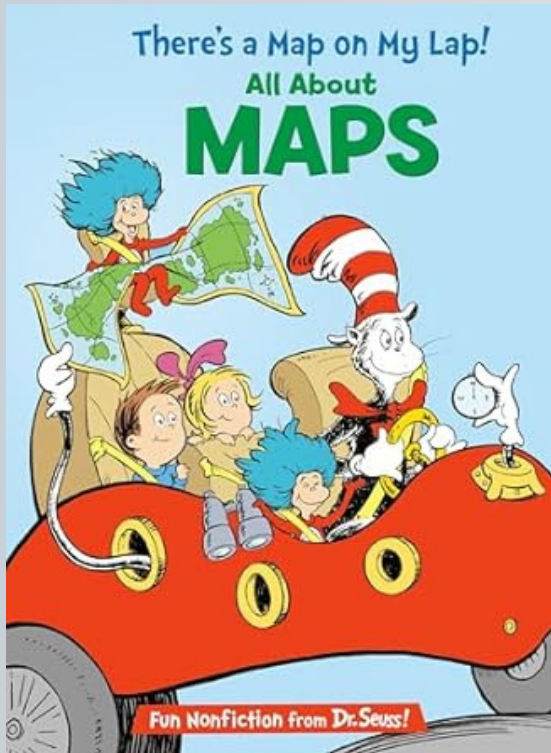

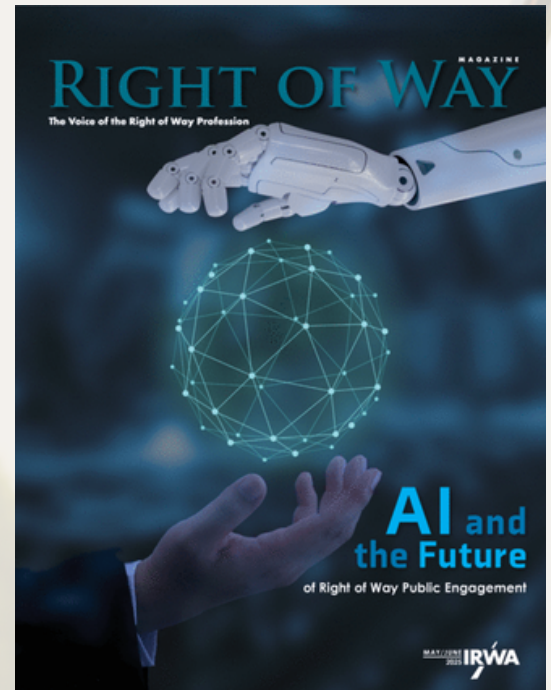

Huntsville, AL, has approved its first sewer rate hike in 20 years to fund a \$150 million upgrade to its aging wastewater system. Starting in 2025, the average monthly bill will increase by \$5, with \$1 annual hikes through 2034. Despite the increase, rates will remain below the state average.

KASSAY'S RAIL TRANSIT BILL PASSES IN FINAL NYS ASSEMBLY SESSION

Assemblywoman Rebecca Kassay's "Furthering Rail Transit in Suffolk County Act" was the last bill passed in the 2025 NYS Assembly session. It grants the MTA a permanent easement to support a new railyard along the Port Jefferson Greenway—paving the way for electrification and modernization of the LIRR's Port Jefferson branch. The bill also ensures future coordination between the DOT and MTA to avoid project conflicts.



The Ronald M. Jourdan SR/WA

Advancement Award

Honoring Excellence and Lifelong Learning in the Right of Way Profession

Ronald M. Jourdan, SR/WA was a member of Chapter 10, Region 5, which includes Michigan (7), Indiana (10), Illinois (12), Ohio (13) Wisconsin (17), West Virginia (21), Kentucky (25), and Western Pennsylvania (88).

THE HISTORY: While serving as IRWA Region 5 Chair (1999-2000), the International Executive Committee (IEC) gave all regions a directive to develop a goal, one that could be instrumental in meeting IRWA's goals and objectives and profit all members. Having taken and passed the (then) Brokers and Salesman's Real Estate Course at IU, I remembered a study course offered to review the B & S Course and prepare for the state exam. I offered this idea to the Region for consideration, to create a similar study course to enhance the number of SR/WA's the Association had. Ron Jourdan, SR/WA, without hesitation, volunteered to spearhead this goal. Joining Ron was Patricia (Pat) Petitto, SR/WA, R/W-RAC, and Russell Oden, SR/WA. The SR/WA Study Course and Exam was born and adopted by the IEC and IRWA.

THE AWARD: The Ronald Jourdan SR/WA Advancement Award was established in February 2005 by the IRWA International Executive Committee (IEC) to honor the memory and legacy of the late Ronald M. Jourdan, SR/WA. Jourdan, who passed away in the fall of 2004, was recognized posthumously as the first recipient of the award, reflecting his significant contributions to the right of way profession. As noted by Gordon MacNair, SR/WA, our 2004-2005 IRWA president, "Throughout his right of way career, Ron unselfishly enhanced the recognition and prestige of the SR/WA designation through his advocacy of high educational and ethical standards and his willingness to share his expertise and experience with others."

He was the driving force in the creation of the SR/WA Study Course and helped many IRWA members achieve the designation." The award was created as a tribute to Jourdan's enduring commitment to professional development, educational excellence, and the advancement of the SR/WA designation within the IRWA community. This award is periodically selected by the IEC.

THE RECIPIENTS: Since 2005, only six IRWA members have received the award, including Ronald M. Jourdan, SR/WA given (posthumously) and accepted by his wife Patty, children Amy and Kirt at our 2005 International Conference), 2006 David Layne, SR/WA, 2020 Carol Brooks, SR/WA, (deceased), 2021 Joe Neighbors, SR/WA, 2022 Janet Walker, SR/WA, and 2023 Faith A. Roland, SR/WA.

Our 2025 recipient of this prestigious award: Mrs. Patricia (Pat) A. Petitto, SR/WA, R/W-RAC, Michigan, Chapter 7, Region 5. Presented to Pat at the 2025 International Education Conference hosted by and held at Virginia Beach, VA., Chapter 52, Region 4. Awarded for her extensive service to all (IRWA) chapter, regional, and international roles, culminating her year as our International President (2012-2013) and her continuing dedication to the profession. Today, continuing her service to IRWA, Pat serves us as Liaison to the Advisory Council (Past International Presidents). I can think of no one more qualified and worthy of this award. We are so immensely proud of you Pat Petitto, SR/WA, RW-RAC. You facilitate our continued passion for Education, Professional Development, Ethics, and continued sharing with others to visualize their professional goals.

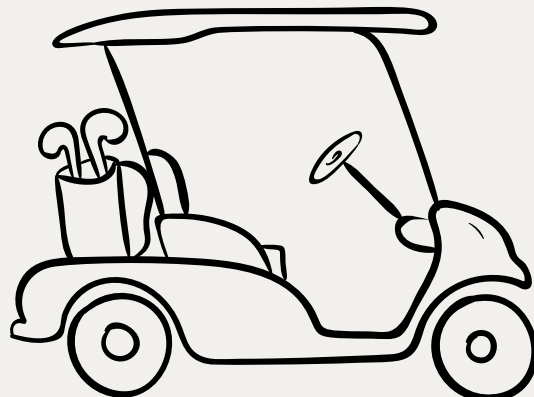


